### FLY:

• Daily flights to Hoedspruit's Eastgate Airport from Johannesburg's OR Tambo

## DRIVE:

- 45 minutes by road from Eastgate Airport. Transfers can be arranged. You will be collected at the reserve gate.
- Six hours by road from Johannesburg, via Polokwane and Tzaneen (recommended route)
